Dear Representative Hastings:

I urge you to call on President Bush to fire John McKay, U.S. Attorney for Western Washington. Mr. McKay has refused to even give a cursory glance at the illegalities and irregularities that occurred in our state's 2004 election – the most tainted election in U.S. history.

Mr. McKay has been given evidence showing that forgeries likely occurred; that thousands of voters voted illegally; and that King County election officials broke the law. Yet, Mr. McKay has done nothing.

Compare this to other states where U.S. Attorneys are actively engaged in investigating, prosecuting and convicting people for election fraud. In those states, which include Wisconsin and Kentucky, the election law violations are minimal compared to what we experienced in our state in 2004.

I presume Mr. McKay has adamantly refused to investigate because he's a Democrat, and any investigation he conducts may harm his future political aspirations.

I thought the process by which Mr. McKay, a Democrat, was appointed was reprehensible (i.e. his brother's connections with Jennifer Dunn). But now it's time for the Administration to admit its mistake and replace Mr. McKay with someone (a Republican?) who will conduct an investigation of election improprieties.
