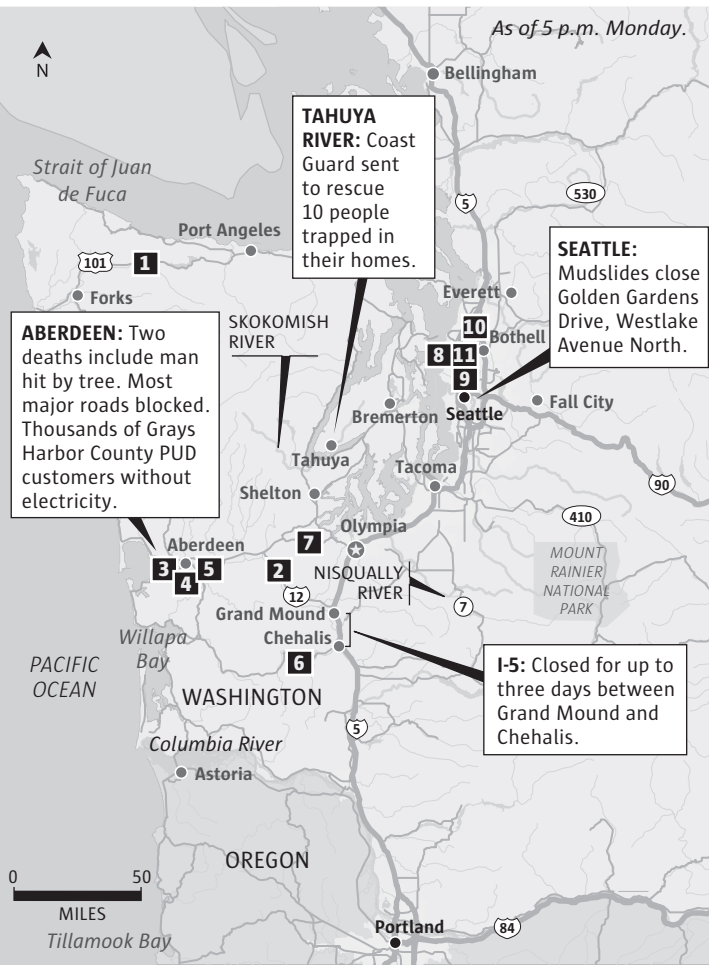


# Areas affected by storm



- 1** Highway 101 closed in several locations due to slides, floods, downed trees and power lines: Hoodsport to Hamma Hamma; Humptulips to Quinalt; at Potlatch.
- 2** Highway 12 closed near Porter, near Elma, and at Aberdeen Lake Road.
- 3** 33,000 Grays Harbor PUD customers without electricity.
- 4** Aberdeen man killed by a falling tree; another man dead of unspecified medical condition when the power went out.
- 5** Two Grays Harbor PUD workers hurt when tree hit a lift-truck bucket Sunday night.
- 6** 80 people reported in distress about 20 miles west of Chehalis at the Chehalis River; Coast Guard helicopters dispatched.
- 7** Landmark eatery Ranch House BBQ wiped out by a mudslide off Highway 8 near Summit Lake.
- 8** Golden Gardens Drive closed until spring after slide Monday. Only victim: a Subaru.
- 9** Mudslide onto Westlake Avenue North. Condo building evacuated.
- 10** Parts of Bothell evacuated because of rising water; Highway 522 closed near I-405.
- 11** Nathan Hale High School closed until Thursday due to flooding on Thornton Creek in Northeast Seattle; several homes flooded.
