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107.	09-20-2000 1115 Hours:	Sgt. McMahon called DPA Mindy Young at the Prosecutor's office inquiring if she had received copies of the additional interviews her office had requested. Young said no, however she was kept informed via phone on all the interviews. Sgt. McMahon requested a copy of the "to do list" that the Prosecutor's office had compiled for the [REDACTED] case. Young said she would fax a copy of the list. McMahon advised Young of the meeting scheduled for 09-21 at 0730 hours in the Prosecutor's office.	
108.	09-20-2000 1200 Hours:	Sgt. McMahon made copies of my investigation starting with item # 59. Sgt. McMahon reviewed the case and compared it to the list. 90% of the list has been completed.	
109.	09-21-2000 0730 Hours:	A/Chief Pirak, Capt Malliet and Sgt. McMahon met with Dan Satterberg and Mark Larson of the Prosecutor's office. Satterberg and Larson discussed potential proof problems with the case and the difficulties that the case presented. All discussed the importance of the interview with [REDACTED]. Captain Malliet confirmed that if the only time the interview could be scheduled was this week 09-21-09-22 prior to Det. Parker's return from vacation then another detective would be assigned to assist with the interview. A/Chief Pirak requested that when a filing decision was reached about the case that both media representatives work together on the press release.	
110.	09-21-2000 1000 Hours:	Sgt. McMahon had a conference call with DPA Scott O'Toole and DPA Mindy Young. They told McMahon that the interview with [REDACTED] was tentatively scheduled for 09-22. O'Toole's preference was to reschedule the meeting for next week when Det. Parker returned from vacation. Sgt. McMahon advised O'Toole that if 09-22 was the only date available - then Det. Fields would conduct the interview. Young said she had prepared a copy of everything she had on the case for Det. Fields. Det. Fields may pick up the packet at the front desk of the Prosecutor's office.

McMahon agreed - but said the interview with [REDACTED] apparently was critical to the decision making process of the Prosecutor's office and therefore had agreed to them. Furthermore, Sgt. McMahon's expectation was that O'Toole and I would meet and review the case thoroughly so O'Toole would be as knowledgeable

The interview conditions are: I was not to conduct the interview but I can be present; the interview would take place at [REDACTED] attorney's office and that the victim and witness statements will be given to the defense attorneys before the interview begins. O'Toole said he was going to conduct the interview. I told O'Toole that I objected to the requests and that it was unacceptable to give the victim and witness statements before charges have been filed.			
116.	09-23-2000 1000 Hours:			I called Sgt. McMahon at home and advised her of the additional restrictions that the Prosecutor's office had agreed to. Sgt. McMahon and I both agreed that this was unacceptable.

118.	09-25-2000 1400 Hours:			Lt. Low and Sgt. McMahon met with SPD legal advisor Leo Port to discuss the Prosecutor's Office request to release the victim and witness statements. ( As a condition for the [REDACTED] interview)			
119.	09-26-2000 1000 Hours:			I met with DPA Scott O'Toole at my office to prepare for the interview with Stevens. O'Toole gave me a copy of the letter from defense counsel Neubauer & Hunsinger. The letter is dated August 25, 2000. This was the first time I saw this letter.
