(V) MICHELLE AND (S) CURTIS HAVE BEEN TOGETHER FOR APPROX 5 YEARS, HAVE BEEN MARRIED FOR ELEVEN MONTHS AND HAVE ONE CHILD IN COMMON.

LATE IN THE EVENING CURTIS AND MICHELLE BECAME INVOLVED IN A DISPUTE OVER CURTIS WANTING TO SPEND TIME WITH HIS FRIENDS RATHER THAN WITH MICHELLE AND THE BABY. AT THEIR APT CURTIS BECAME UPSET BECAUSE MICHELLE HAD HIDDEN THE CAR ALARM DEACTIVATED KEY, AND HE WANTED THE CAR KEY TO LEAVE WHEN MICHELLE WOULD NOT TELL HIM WHERE THE KEY WAS HE BEGAN TO CHOKE HER WITH HIS HANDS. MICHELLE CLAIMS TO HAVE PASSED OUT FOR AN UNKNOWN AMOUNT OF TIME, BUT WOKE UP COUGHING AND VOMITED. CURTIS CONTINUED WANTING TO KNOW WHERE THE KEY WAS AND BIT HIS FOREARM ON MICHELLE'S THROAT CHOKING HER AGAIN, BUT SHE DID NOT PASS OUT.

CURTIS THEN LET MICHELLE UP AND SHE WENT TO THE LIVING ROOM AND CALLED 911. CURTIS WAS GOA PRIOR TO POLICE ARRIVAL. OFC. WALKER AND I BOTH OBSERVED THE LISTED INJURIES TO THE THROAT OF MICHELLE. WHEN MICHELLE WAS TELLING US OF THE INCIDENT SHE WAS CRYING, HER FACE WAS RED, AND HER HAIR WAS MESSED UP. SHE PROVIDED ME WITH A STATEMENT ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND ADVISED ME OF PAST INCIDENTS. MICHELLE ALSO ADVISED THAT CURTIS MAY BE IN THE AREA OF THE UNIV. OF WASHINGTON. I CALLED AND ADVISED U.W. POLICE ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND I WAS GIVEN 6 CASE NUMBERS OF PRIOR D.V. CALLS U.W. POLICE AND SPD HAD RESPONDED TO INVOLVING CURTIS AND MICHELLE.

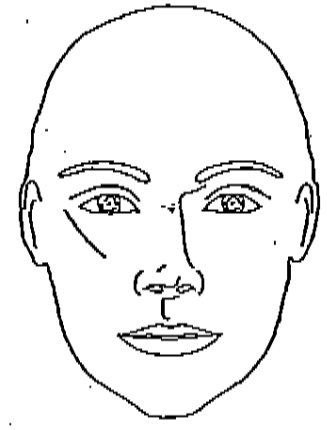
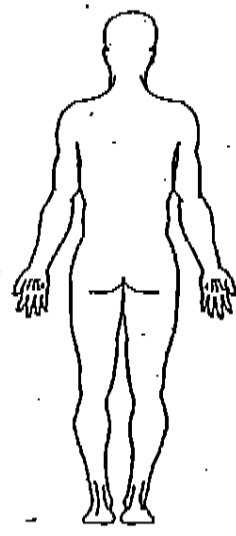
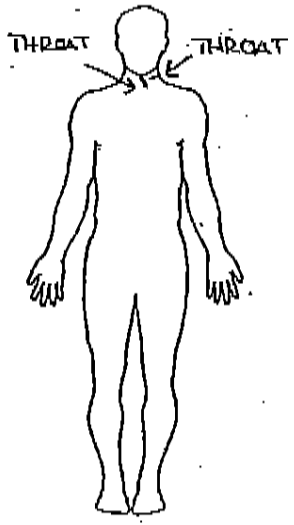

THE KEY. I WAS ON THE BED AND CURTIS APPROACHED ME AND PUT BOTH OF HIS HANDS ON MY THROAT AND HE STARTED TO CHOKE ME. HE WAS SAYING WHERE WERE THE KEYS AND WHY DID I MAKE HIM DO THIS TO ME. I PASSED OUT AND WOKE UP MAYBE 30 SECONDS LATER COUGHING AND I THREW UP. CURTIS WAS STILL TRYING TO FIND OUT WHERE THE KEY WAS THEN HE PUT HIS FOREARM ACROSS MY THROAT. HE WAS PUSHING DOWN WITH HIS FOREARM AND I STARTED TO CHOKE AGAIN, BUT I DID NOT PASS OUT. CURTIS STOPPED AND STARTED TEARING APART THE ROOM LOOKING FOR THE KEY. I WENT OUT INTO THE LIVING ROOM AND STARTED FOLDING CLOTHES. HE CAME INTO THE LIVING ROOM AND KEPT HOWLING AT ME SO I STARTED TO CALL 911. CURTIS LOOKED AT ME IN SHOCK, TOOK SOME CLOTHES AND LEFT THE APARTMENT. HE DID NOT TAKE THE ALARM ACTIVATOR TO THE CAR. WHEN CURTIS TOOK THE CAR I COULD HEAR THE ALARM GOING OFF AS HE DROVE AWAY.

THIS IS NOT THE FIRST TIME CURTIS HAS CHOKED ME. HE HAS BROKEN MY ARM IN THE PAST AND CUT MY FACE WITH A KEY. HE HAS TOLD ME NOT TO TELL ANYONE ABOUT WHAT HAPPENS, BUT I CANNOT TAKE IT ANYMORE.

ON 060197 AT APPROX 0013HRS I RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A SEPERATED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AT 1722-NE145 #302. WHEN I ARRIVED I WAITED FOR THE SECOND RESPONDING UNIT, BUT THEN CONTACTED THE VICTIM WHEN K.C. RADIO ADVISED ME SHE HAD BEEN CHOKED AND PASSED OUT.

I CONTACTED THE VICTIM, MICHELLE A. WILLIAMS, WHO WAS CRYING AND I SAW THAT HER FACE WAS RED AND HER HAIR WAS MESSSED UP. SHE EXPLAINED THAT HER HUSBAND, CURTIS E. WILLIAMS, HAD CHOKED HER TWICE AND THAT SHE HAD PASSED OUT ONCE. CURTIS HAD DONE THIS BECAUSE HE WAS UPSET BECAUSE MICHELLE HAD HIDDEN THE CAR KEY AND HE WANTED TO BE WITH FRIENDS. CURTIS LEFT WHEN MICHELLE CALLED 911.

I SAW AN APPROX 2" LONG RED MARK ON HER THROAT AND RED MARKS TO THE LEFT SIDE OF HER NECK. I ALSO SAW A RED MARK NEXT TO HER RIGHT EYE, BUT SHE TOLD ME IT WAS A SCAR FROM A PRIOR INCIDENT. MICHELLE ADVISED ME THAT CURTIS MAY BE ON THE UNIV. OF WASHINGTON CAMPUS. I SPOKE WITH A POLICE DISPATCHER WITH THE U.W. POLICE AND ADVISED HER OF THE SITUATION AND THAT I HAD P.C. TO ARREST CURTIS. THE DISPATCHER ADVISED ME OF SIX PRIOR INCIDENTS OF D.V. BETWEEN CURTIS AND MICHELLE.

DEP. WALKER, WHO HAD ALSO RESPONDED TO THIS INCIDENT, OBTAINED INFO # THAT A VALID NO CONTACT ORDER EXISTED LISTING MICHELLE AS THE PETITIONER AND CURTIS AS THE RESPONDANT. THE ORDER WAS VERIFIED WITH K.C. DATA AND SHOWED ISSUED AND SERVED ON 03197 BY SEATTLE DIST. COURT #C034130W. THE ORDER WAS NOW EXPIRING AND HAD THE FELONY CLAUSE. DEP. WALKER TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF MICHELLE'S INJURIES AND I TOOK A WRITTEN STATEMENT ABOUT THE INCIDENT. MICHELLE SIGNED A MEDICAL RELEASE FORM AND I GAVE HER A DVPA FORM, ALTHOUGH MICHELLE APPEARED AFRAID THAT CURTIS WOULD RETURN SHE REBUSED MY OFFER OF FINDING A SHELTER FOR HER AND HER CHILD.

AT APPROX 0722HR WHILE I WAS AGAIN ON PATROL K.C. RADIO ADVISED ME CURTIS HAD RETURNED TO THE RESIDENCE. I RESPONDED WITH A K-9 UNIT TO THE RESIDENCE AND FOUND CURTIS IN THE BEDROOM. I PLACED HIM INTO CUSTODY WITHOUT INCIDENT AND ADVISED HIM OF HIS RIGHT TO A LANYER. I TOOK HIM TO MY PATROL CAR AND AT 0732HRS I ADVISED CURTIS OF HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS WHICH HE ACKNOWLEDGED AND WAIVED. CURTIS WAS CRYING AND TOLD ME OF AN ARGUMENT HE AND MICHELLE HAD, BUT DENIED CHOKING HER. CURTIS WAS BOOKED INTO K.C. JAIL FOR ASSAULT 2ND AND FELONY VIOLATION OF A NO CONTACT ORDER. I TRANSPORTED CURTIS TO K.C.-J. AND COMPLETED THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK ENDING MY INVOLVEMENT IN THIS CASE.

My name is Steven H. Robinson. I am employed as a police sergeant by the University of Washington Police Department, 1117 NE Boat Street, Seattle, WA 98105. My work telephone is

On December 7, 1996 about 0208 hours I heard Officer Deaner and Off. Schreven dispatched to a possible family disturbance at unit X274 Laurel Village, 4200 Mary Gates Way NE, a campus family housing facility. Shortly after these two officers arrived I heard over the radio that they were not having anyone responded to their knocking at the door. I decided to respond to the area to see if they needed further assistance with the call. When I arrived, a little after 0230 hours I saw the door to apartment X274 was open and I could hear people talking. I listened at the door and heard Off. Schreven asking someone if they could get dressed and come out of the bathroom. I entered the apartment and Off. Schreven was bringing a white female, later identified as Michelle A. Williams, down the stairs and into the living room. Mrs. Williams indicated that she had got out of hand and was throwing a tantrum because she had just heard her grandmother had died. She said she was crying and her husband, Curtis E. Williams, had tried to restrain her. She had pushed away from him. Furthermore, that while they were lying in their bed she had slammed her face into the wall and caused her bloody nose. She was adamant that her husband had not struck her.

I went up the stairs to the bedroom area where Curtis Williams and his daughter were. In the bedroom I could see a large pool of drying blood on a light colored pillow, which was about 18" inches from the wall. The bed was a mattress and box spring set on the floor in the South East corner of the bedroom. The mattress had a black colored sheet and I could see other pools of drying blood on the sheet leading toward the bedroom door. There were bloody finger prints on the wall surrounding the light switch cover and light switch. I followed blood drops on the carpet from the mattress to the bathroom. The tub and shower were wet as if some one had just taken a shower. The tub was clear of blood, but there were drops of dried blood on the tiled floor. I found a pile of women's clothes behind the bathroom door.
