I, Daniel T. Satterberg, Prosecuting Attorney for King County in the name and by the authority of the State of Washington, do accuse JOSE ANGEL BLANCO AKA JOSE NARANJO-BLANCO of the crime of **Murder in the First Degree**, committed as follows:

That the defendant JOSE ANGEL BLANCO AKA JOSE NARANJO-BLANCO in King County, Washington, on or about November 30, 2008, with premeditated intent to cause the death of another person, did cause the death of Noemi Lopez, a human being, who died on or about November 30, 2008;

Contrary to RCW 9A.32.030(1)(a), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

And I, Daniel T. Satterberg, Prosecuting Attorney for King County in the name and by the authority of the State of Washington further do accuse the defendant JOSE ANGEL BLANCO AKA JOSE NARANJO-BLANCO at said time of being armed with a deadly weapon, to-wit: a knife, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.602 and 9.94A.533(4).

**CERTIFICATION FOR DETERMINATION
OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

That Steve Kilburg is a Detective with the Seattle Police Department and has reviewed the investigation conducted in Seattle Police Department Case Number 08-447777;

There is probable cause to believe that Jose Angel Blanco-Naranjo (dob 10/23/69) committed the crime(s) of Murder.

This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

On Sunday, November 30th, 2008, at 4:26 p.m., Seattle Police were called to a home located at 7628 46th Avenue S. in Seattle, King County, Washington. Seattle Police and Seattle Fire responded and found Noemi L. Lopez (dob 4/17/77) lying on the living room floor, deceased from multiple stab wounds.

Ms Lopez lived at this home with her three children. Ms. Lopez's ex-husband, the defendant Jose Angel Blanco-Naranjo (dob 10/23/69), frequently stayed at Ms. Lopez's home. The defendant had been at the home on November 30th. Ms. Lopez's fifteen year old daughter stated that her father and mother had argued that morning, but she had neither seen nor heard any physical attack. The defendant had left the house for a short time said the daughter, but had returned to the home before she and her two siblings had left for church at 12:30 p.m. When the children left, Ms. Lopez was left alone in the company of the defendant. At approximately 2:45 p.m., the daughter received a voice mail on her cellular phone from the defendant. The defendant told his daughter to not go into the house with the other children and that he was sorry for what he had done. The aunt who had taken the children to church and the children returned home immediately and found Lopez lying on the living room floor, obviously deceased from stab wounds.

At approximately 3:00 p.m on November 30th, the defendant called his cousin, Rafael Del Rio in Fresno, California. The defendant said that he was trying to get a hold of his sister who had taken the children to church. Del Rio thought that the defendant was talking anxiously and asked what was wrong. The defendant stated that he had just killed his ex-wife. When Del Rio exclaimed that maybe she was only hurt, the defendant stated, no, he had killed her. The defendant also asked for an aunt's phone number in Mexico so that he could get a hold of his brother. Del Rio said that he and the defendant are not that close. The defendant often asked for money, but the purpose of this phone call clearly was for the phone numbers.

Family members said that the defendant recently threatened to take his life and to take 2 or 3 others with him. Blanco has been hospitalized at Harborview Medical Center in the past for an intentional drug and alcohol overdose.

Seattle Police Crime Scene Investigation detectives processed the crime scene and King County Medical Examiner personnel responded. Dr Aldo Fusaro examined Ms. Lopez's body at the scene and at autopsy. Lopez was found lying on her back on the living room floor, her arms were extended out and her legs were straight. She was dressed in running shorts, a bra, and t-shirt. Lopez suffered over 60 stab and incision wounds to her chest, back, arms, hands, and right knee. At least half of these wounds were defensive wounds to her hands and arms. Blood evidence at the scene indicates that the attack was confined to the living room area where Lopez was found. Knives were collected from the kitchen, but the murder weapon appears to be absent from the house. Bloody evidence collected from the bathroom suggests that the defendant may have cleaned up before he left.

Relatives and the children do not have a permanent address for the defendant. Several local addresses associated with the defendant have been checked without success. The family described the defendant as a gambler who is always borrowing money. Blanco is driving his silver 2001 BMW 3 series four-door sedan, Washington license 732PPB. An alert was broadcast for Blanco and his car, and distributed in the western United States.

REQUEST FOR BAIL

The State requests bail in the amount of \$1,000,000.00. The defendant is an extreme danger to the community as evidenced by the brutal stabbing he inflicted upon the mother of his children. The defendant has no known residence in King County other than the scene of the murder. The defendant is currently evaded police and has made phone calls attempting to make contact with relatives in Mexico. It is believed that the defendant is attempting to flee the country. The defendant faces a minimum mandatory sentence of 22 years on the current charge.


The amount of bail requested is appropriate.
