
Dear Ms. Willmsen:

Thank you for your public records request of February 19, 2010 asking for a list of the pending Public Disclosure requests with the City of Lakewood.

On February 22, 2010 I called you back and spoke with you to clarify the request and you stated you were specifically looking for requests involving the Maurice Clemmons family and the murder of our Lakewood Police Officers on November 29, 2009. I told you that the only public disclosure request I have received regarding this incident was one from the insurance company that represent's Forza Coffee. I advised you that I referred that requestor to the Pierce County Sheriff's Department as the incident occurred within their jurisdiction and they handled the complete investigation. A check of my records confirms this is the only request concerning our police tragedy and Maurice Clemmons.
