

# Burke's empire

Suzie Burke owns some 35 acres of Fremont – about half its commercial and industrial land. She usually leases the grounds to others who develop it. Her property has been home to everything from Internet companies to artists' work spaces to parking lots. Below are some of the major buildings on her property.

## Redhook Ale Brewery

The building, owned by Pacific Realty Associates L.P., a Portland-based real-estate development company, sits on land purchased by Burke and her father in 1983. It's housed Redhook since 1988.

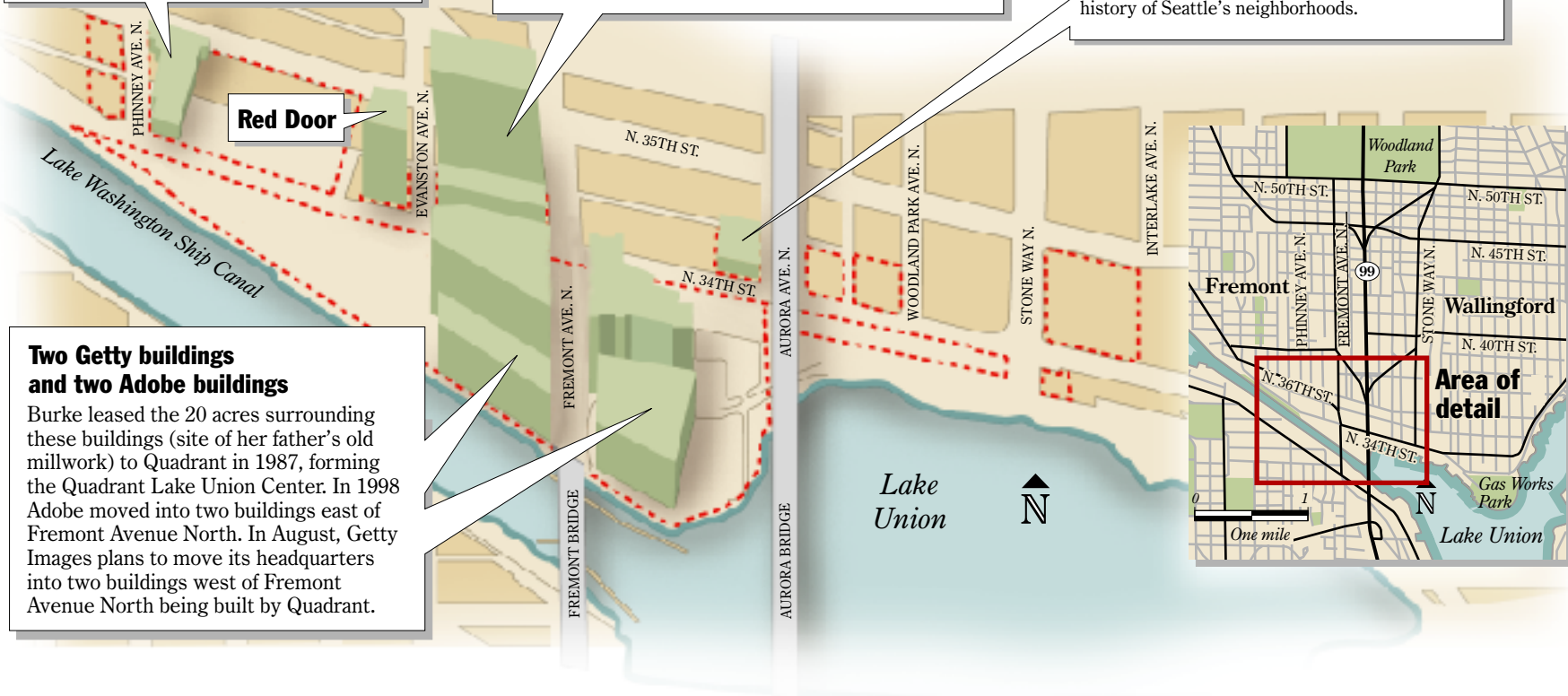
## Apartment complex/former Red Door site

The former site of the Red Door Alehouse, Burke's first solo land purchase in 1985. The building, which Burke bought in 1986, was moved one block west in June to make room for a 130-room apartment/retail/restaurant/parking complex built by Fremont Housing Group.

## Two Getty buildings and two Adobe buildings

Burke leased the 20 acres surrounding these buildings (site of her father's old millwork) to Quadrant in 1987, forming the Quadrant Lake Union Center. In 1998 Adobe moved into two buildings east of Fremont Avenue North. In August, Getty Images plans to move its headquarters into two buildings west of Fremont Avenue North being built by Quadrant.
