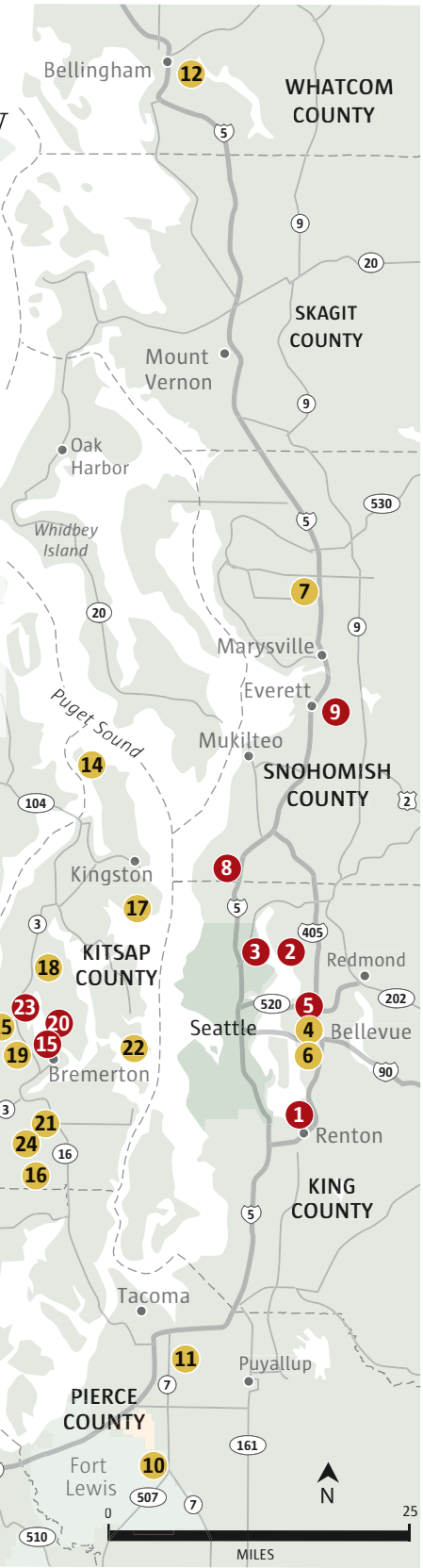


Beaches with an unhealthy history

A handful of beaches around Puget Sound show signs of chronic contamination that could sicken swimmers.

- **Moderate** pollution levels in recent years. Not enough to trigger a closure, but higher than average.
- **Repeated** pollution in recent years at levels that would trigger beach closures or advisories.
