2 [*dialing/ringing*]

3 PERSON 2: El Paso.

4 DAVID: Hey, ah, this is David up at Enron.

5 PERSON 2: Uh huh.

6 DAVID: I was wondering, um, the demand out there is r – there's not much, ah, demand
7 for power at all and we're running kind of fat. Um, if you took down the steamer, how long
8 would it take to get it back up?

9 PERSON 2: Oh, it's not something you want to just be turning on and off every hour. Let's
10 put it that way.

11 DAVID: Yeah. Yeah. Um –

12 PERSON 2: And it depends on time, ah, how long it's off and what have you.

13 DAVID: Yeah. Well, I don't know, my guess is these cuts are going to keep goin' on for
14 another couple hours and ah, if – if we shut it down, could you bring it back up in three –
15 three or four hours, something like that?

16 PERSON 2: Oh, yeah.

17 DAVID: Well, why don't you just go ahead and shut her down, then, if that's OK.

18 PERSON 2: OK.

19 DAVID: And I'm showin' it's ah, ah, generating 103 right now. When you shut it down it
20 just goes down to about a 36 or something, is that about right?

21 PERSON 2: Nnnno, it –

22 DAVID: [*inaudible*]

23 PERSON 2: -- should be less than twenty.

24 DAVID: Go – go to less than 20? OK.

25 PERSON 2: Uh huh.

26 DAVID: OK. Yeah, just go ahead, do that and ah, I'll – I'll try to give you a hour's notice or
27 m – more to [*inaudible*] need to come back up.

28 PERSON 2: What's goin' on for hour two, or do you know yet?

1 DAVID: Um, hour two, we take it down for hour two. That was my point.
2 PERSON 2: No, I mean what is goin' on on the ISO schedules?
3 DAVID: Oh, well, with the schedule? Yeah, um, ah, PNM is goin' from 11 down to 1 in
4 hour 2.
5 PERSON 2: Uh huh.
6 DAVID: Ah, excuse me, from ah, 9 down to one. They're at 9 right now, they're going to
7 go down to one. And ah –
8 PERSON 2: What a – then the ISO you don't know yet?
9 DAVID: Ah, ISO hadn't ah, told us anything. We're just kind of assuming that some of this
10 stuff's going to get cut again and – and we're running fat enough to where he shut down the,
11 ah, steamer when we take – there'll be a net, ah, decrease of about 80 it will be all right to,
12 ah, still meet the load.
13 PERSON 2: OK.
14 DAVID: OK?
15 PERSON 2: Okee doke.
16 DAVID: OK, so I'll just keep you – I'll check back in with you again this steamer situation,
17 but I guess just go ahead and take it down for now, if it's all right.
18 PERSON 2: Right.
19 DAVID: OK?

22 PERSON 2: El Paso.
23 DAVID: Hey, ah, this is David callin'. I j – I – I was given the changes on the, ah, on the
24 ah – on the schedule.
25 PERSON 2: OK, ah, can you hold [*inaudible*]?
26 DAVID: Sure, yeah.
27 PERSON 2: He's ah, checkin' out with somebody else. You got a lot of them?
28 DAVID: What's that?

1 PERSON 2: You got a lot of 'em?

2 DAVID: No, no, no, no, no, no, ah, just that ah, I pretty much told him what the – what
3 was goin' on. The, ah, um, PNM was goin' from 9 down to 1, I told him that, but I was also
4 going to tell him that ah, ah, we were selling 50 to ah, Tucson. That should go to zero.

5 PERSON 2: Oh, 50 goes to zero at Tucson.

6 DAVID: Yeah, that was a – that was a 50 [*inaudible*] goin' to zero.

7 PERSON 2: Does he know about that one?

8 DAVID: No, that's what I was callin' back to tell him about.

9 PERSON 2: Oh, he knows about the PNM contingent, right?

10 DAVID: Yeah, yeah.

11 PERSON 2: So, I just tell him that Tucson goes to zero.

12 DAVID: Bingo. Yeah.

13 PERSON 2: OK.
